New to FSA? **Create an FSA ID** account below. An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member.

You are not allowed to have an employee or agent of a commercial entity, or other third party, create an FSA ID for you for any purposes including but not limited to: payment reductions, debt consolidation or applying for aid. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

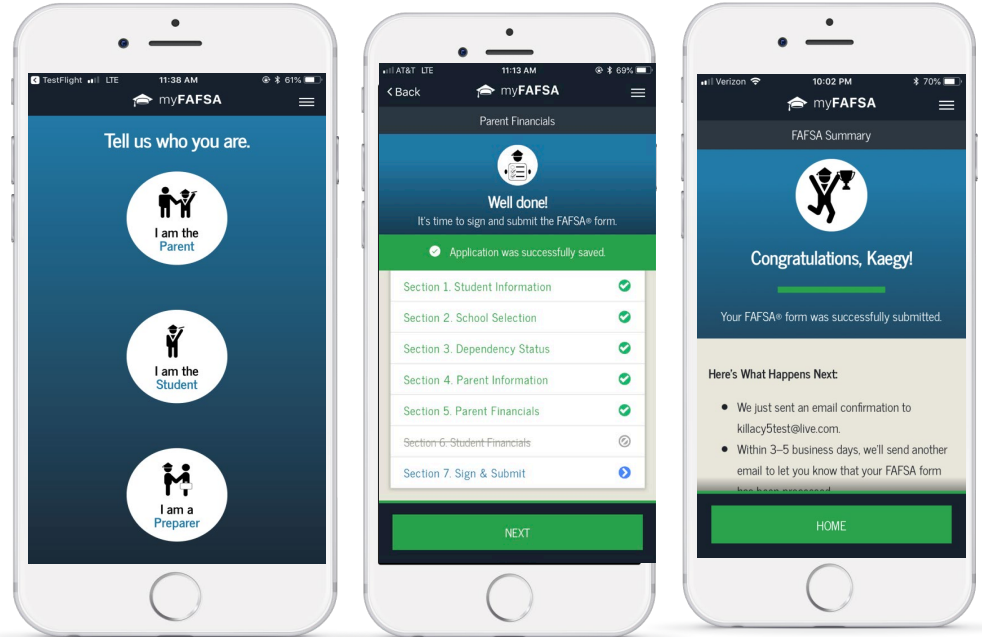

FAFSA Completion:

You will receive a SAR (Student Aid Report) to your email that contains:

- All information you entered into the FAFSA.
- Your Estimated Family Contribution (EFC), an estimate of what your family can contribute to paying for your education, according to the FAFSA.
- Additional information or issues identified by the Department of Education (labeled “WHAT YOU MUST DO NOW”).

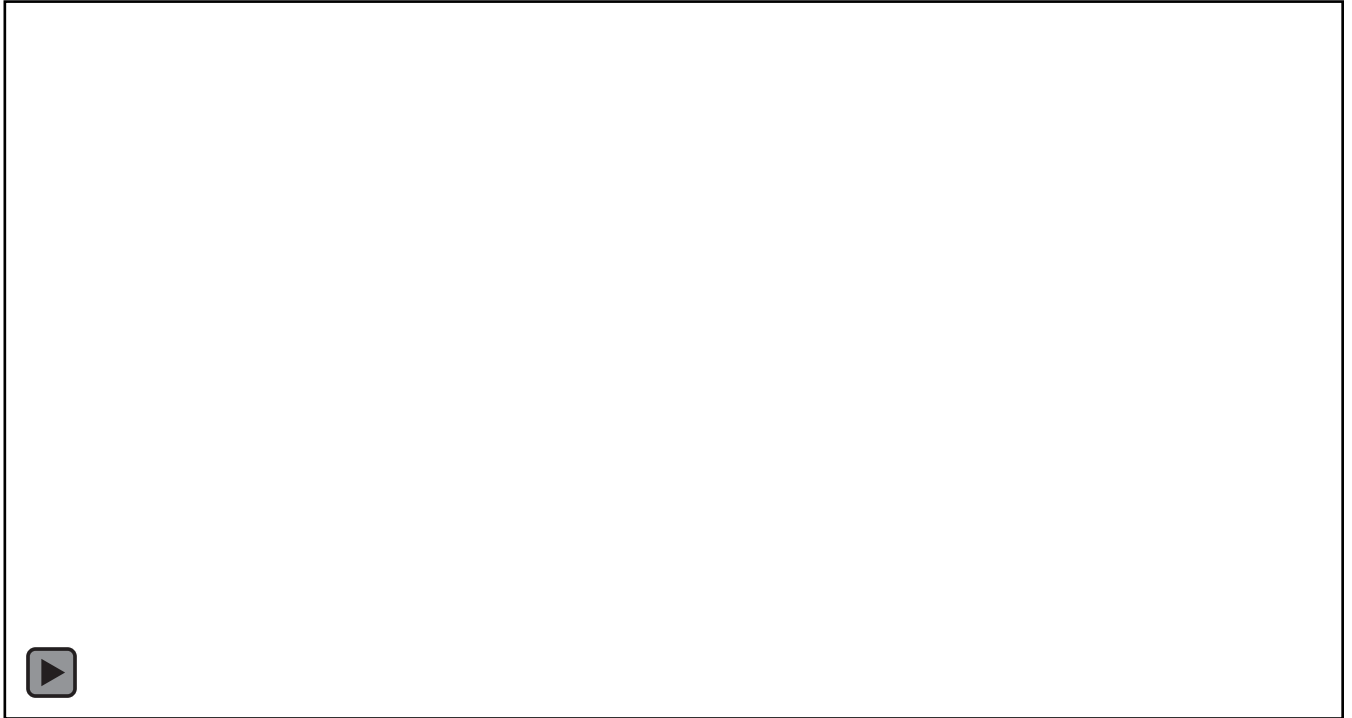
Outstanding Requirements

- Resolve conflicting information
 - Incorrect SSN
 - Verification Selection
 - Typos (Income Information)
 - Missing Signature
- Notification of outstanding requirements?
 - Sent to the student's "my.westga.edu" email address.
- Requirements must be resolved before financial aid can be awarded

The Yellow Handout – Needs Work!

To view Outstanding Requirements:

1. Select the "myUWG" log-in link from the main UWG website and log-in using your credentials
2. Select the "Banweb" tab once logged in
3. Select "Student Services and Financial Aid"
4. Select "Financial Aid"
5. Select "My Eligibility"
6. Select "Eligibility Requirements"
7. Sign-in using your full myuwg email address (including the @my.westga.edu) and Banweb password
8. You will be prompted to confirm your FAFSA information and will have the option to sign up to receive text message notifications regarding the status of your documents.

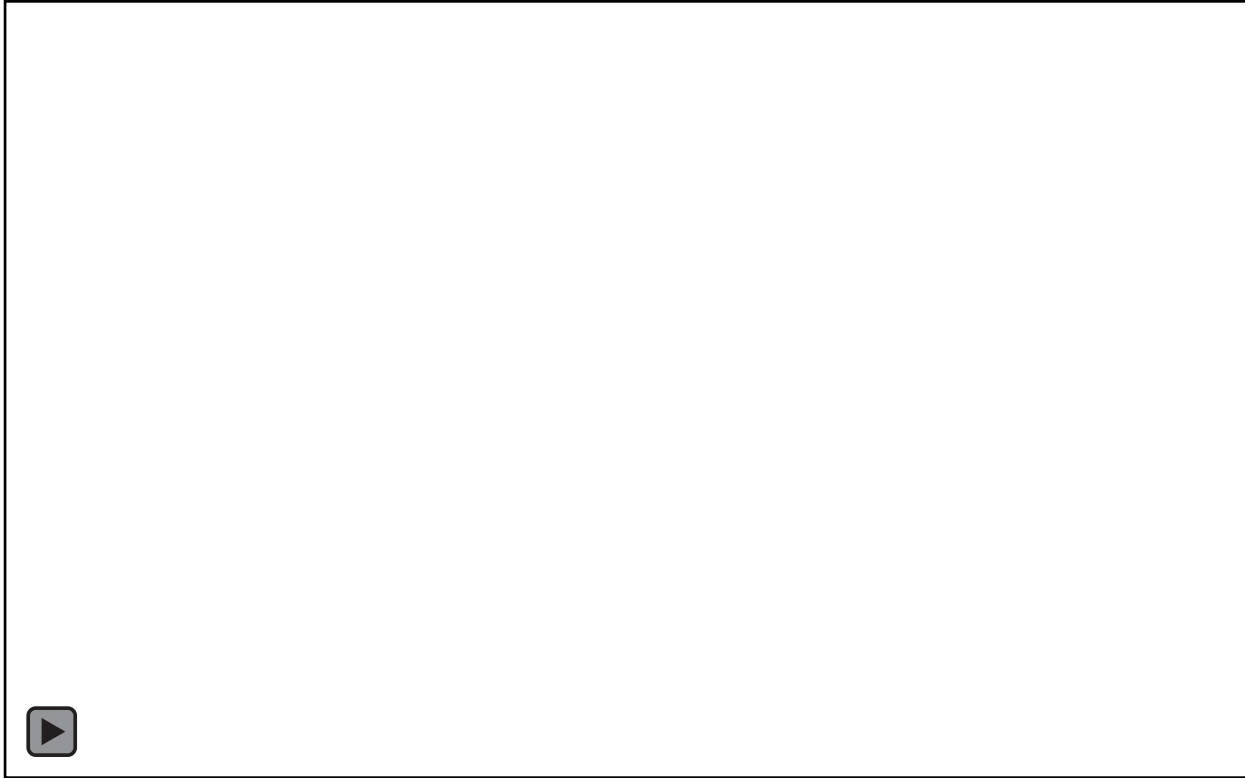

Your Financial Aid Award

- Notifications: “my.westga.edu” email address and letters are mailed to home addresses
- “Free Aid” is automatically accepted
 - Scholarships
 - Pell Grant (If eligible)
- Student Loans are Offered
 - Can be accepted in Banweb
- Parent PLUS Loan is Offered
 - **Cannot** be accepted in Banweb
- Federal Work-Study Offer
 - Not applied to bill

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Types of Aid Awarded

- Pell Grant
 - Depends on Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) and number of hours enrolled
- Federal Work Study
 - Allows a student to apply for FWSP-eligible positions through Career Services, does not guarantee a position
 - Allowed to work up to 20 hours per week and paid an hourly wage in a bi-weekly paycheck
 - Search “WolfWorks” on westga.edu for more information
- Direct Student Loans
 - Undergraduate Subsidized, Unsubsidized
- Parent PLUS – Biological/Adoptive parent ONLY

Accepting Student Loans

- If loans are needed:
 - Student must accept loans on Banweb
 - Accepting a student loan is committing to repayment with interest (fixed at 5.05%)
 - Federal Loan Origination Fee
 - 1.062% (Subsidized/Unsubsidized)
- Find instructions to accept loans on our website, www.westga.edu/finaid
 - Or scan your QR Code

Loan Borrowing Requirements

- In addition to accepting students loans, the Department of Education has requirements that must be completed at www.studentloans.gov.
 - Sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN)
 - Complete a Loan Entrance Counseling Session
- For student loans, the student must complete using their FSA ID.
- Once completed, please allow 2-3 business days for the loans to be applied to your account.

Parent PLUS Loans

- If additional aid is needed:
 - Biological or adoptive parent may complete an application for a Parent PLUS Loan online at www.studentloans.gov
 - Find instructions on our website: www.westga.edu/finaid.
- Parent applicant is subjected to a credit check
 - Accepted credit will result in origination of a Parent PLUS Loan with a commitment to repayment with interest (fixed at 7.6%)
 - Federal Loan Origination Fee = 4.248%
 - Denied credit will result in offer of additional unsubsidized loan to student on Banweb
 - Refusal to apply or borrow a Parent PLUS Loan will not result in an additional unsubsidized loan offer to student
- Parent Disbursement Requirements (For Accepted Credit Decisions)
 - To be completed on studentloans.gov with the parent's FSA ID
 - PLUS Master Promissory Note (Parent Borrower)
 - PLUS Credit Counseling Session

Additional Funding Options

Parent PLUS Loan

Your parent can apply for a Parent PLUS Loan through www.studentloans.gov using their FSA ID.

- This application must be completed by your biological/adoptive parent, or a step-parent married to a biological or adoptive parent.
- If your parent is denied, you are eligible to receive additional unsubsidized loan funding.

Private Student Loan

You may apply for additional student loan funding through a private student loan lender. A list of lenders our students often use may be found on our website. However, this is not an exhaustive list and is provided as a courtesy.

Netnet Payment Plan

Offered through the Bursar's Office, this payment plan allows students to pay Tuition & Fees in installments, helping make college more affordable. See the handout in your Orientation bag for more information!

Private Scholarships

- Many of our students receive private scholarships through local organizations in their hometown. Don't forget to check with your local high school, community center, church, and businesses!
- Search for private scholarships online or through our resources provided in the Enrollment Services Center! Remember- you should never be required pay to complete a scholarship application.

 - You have the freedom to decide housing and meal plan options.

Federal Student Loan Award Amounts

- Sophomores = \$3,250
- Juniors/Seniors = \$3,750

Covering your Balance

- Nelnet Payment Plan
 - Allows students to pay tuition and fees in installments.
 - The payment plan is **not** a loan: has no credit checks, interest, or finance charges associated with the plan. Enrollment fees do apply.
 - The payment plan can cover any tuition, student fees, meal plan, and on-campus housing charges **up to \$5,500.00**.
- The payment plan does not adjust automatically due to an increase or decrease in charges. Any changes to the Payment Plan must be communicated to the Bursar's Office.

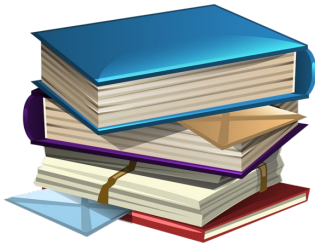
Covering your Balance

 - Denied – Student is awarded an additional unsubsidized loan
 - \$4,000 (Freshmen and Sophomores, annual)
 - \$5,000 (Juniors and Seniors, annual)

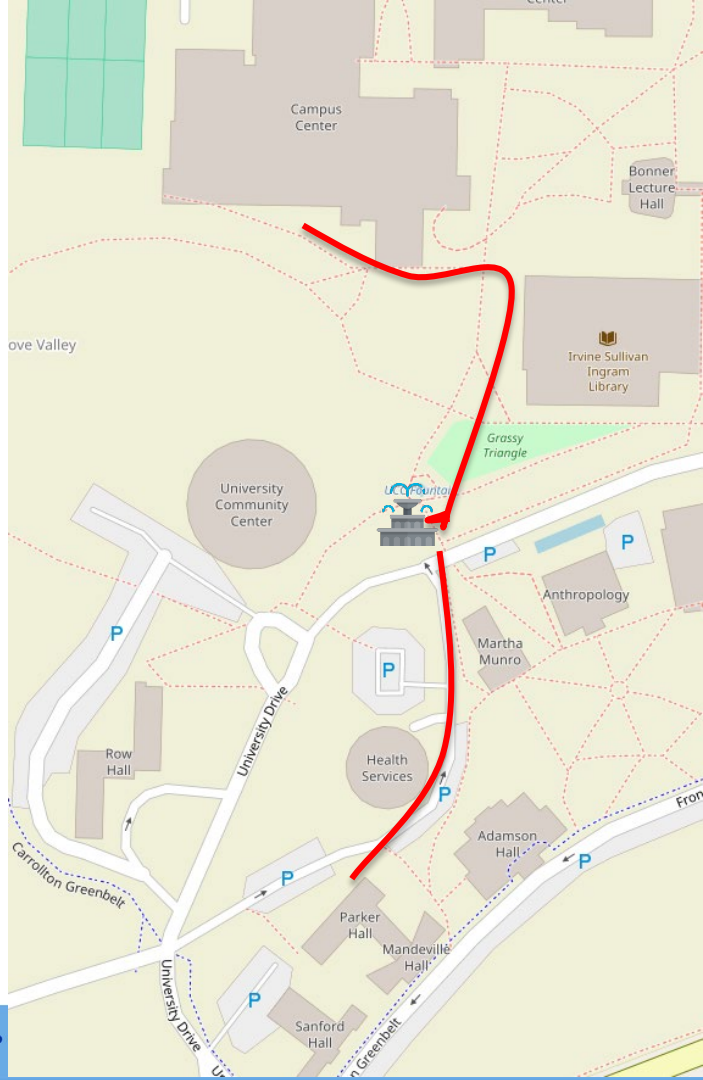
